We have been seeding since February when snow and ice covered every greenhouse and path. Brrrrr.... The determination of seed to grow always amazes me!

Our vegetable list seems to expand each spring. We have added Artichokes, three colors of Beets, a violet Cauliflower, Winter Red Kale, kohlrabi, Diplomat – a tropical Melon, more Leeks and more Onions, Ancho Peppers, Winter Luxury – a tasty pie Pumpkin, Delicata and Spaghetti Squash, Bush Baby Zucchini, Sugar Baby Watermelon and thirty-six varieties of Tomatoes.

Many of you grow vegetables in containers which works great.

Start with new soil each year. Please note that all soils are not created equal. Use a soil that has been created with drainage and nutrition and is sterile (not from the garden). Our favorite soils are available in our shop.

Mix flowers, vegetables and herbs in your containers.

And FEED! Use an organic fertilizer - either dry or liquid regularly.
